**Track One:** The major/minor track divides 36 quarter hours into two sections (24 hours of coursework in either the Biblical Studies Department or the Christian History, Theology, and Philosophy Department and 12 hours in the other department); it includes an additional 4 quarter hours for the Senior Seminar and 4 quarter hours of a general elective.  
**Track Two:** The general track includes 36 quarter hours from courses in the Biblical Studies and the Christian History, Theology, and Philosophy Departments (at least two courses must be taken from each department), 4 quarter hours for the Senior Seminar, and 4 quarter hours of a general elective.
