Appleseed Community Mental Health Center has an immediate need for a highly skilled Substance Use Disorder therapist/social worker to work at our Rape Crisis Domestic Violence Safe Haven and in the local jail. The successful candidate will have experience working with adults, youth, families, and/or groups. This position will provide Trauma Informed education and outreach to domestic and/or sexual violence survivors, secondary survivors, those experiencing emotional or behavioral mental health concerns, substance use disorders, and the community at large. Will provide training in sexual violence and domestic violence and must have the ability to relate effectively with a diverse population. Master degree required with MSW, LISW, LPC, LPCC, MFT, or LICDC. Must have a car available during working hours, carry and maintain automobile insurance that includes a payable liability of \$100,000/\$300,000, as well as the ability to legally drive a car. Must pass background and driving record checks and drug test.
