The Masontown Brethren Church was established in 1884. Since then, the faithful followers have shared the love of Christ throughout the community. The church promotes Christian education, Spiritual growth, missions, and church work.

We are a busy and an active church, not only on Sunday morning, but all week. Currently, we have 50-65 attendees in morning worship and about 30 in Sunday School. We love to have social gatherings and fellowship.

We have an active Sunday School for all ages, men and women's Bible studies, a Women's Missionary Society, and a puppet ministry.

Volunteers from the church work with Cornerstone Ministries for school release time. Interested children from the nearby Masontown Elementary school can come to our church during school hours for a Bible lesson twice a month during the school year.

Some of the other activities the church is involved in include shoe boxes for Samaritan's Purse, bimonthly blood drives, Facebook live feed of the morning service, community activities, and youth programs. A ministry council coordinates our outreach program.

Lead the ministry council and meet and advise all church ministries.

Work with the deacon board to establish and exercise a visitation program of the membership.

Lead and encourage the church toward a positive direction of the ministry, church growth, church health, problem solving, and leading of the Holy Spirit.

Be involved in continuing education and study to develop God's gifts.

Participate or promote with Regional and National boards, committees, and Camp, as well as local ecumenical church activities as practical.

Will adhere to polity and doctrine of the Brethren Church Ashland Ohio.
